Science Kit Phase-out FAQs for Partners

1. Why is the Science Kit - Physics Lab being phased out?
After careful consideration and review of how the Science Kit is being used in the classroom, we have taken the decision to phase the kit out of our portfolio to enable us to better integrate a pure science focus in the future. This will include developing the existing content and creating new content and functionality on the Arduino Science Journal app.
2. Is the kit being replaced?
No, not directly. Students and educators can, however, still conduct exciting science experiments using the Arduino Science Journal app and the Nano 33 BLE Sense board.
3. Will existing customers still be able to access online content and support?
Yes. We will still support the existing online content that comes with the Science Kit. Existing users will be able to use the kit and access all the online resources as normal. Our customer support team will still be available to answer any questions and resolve any issues users have.
4. How should I communicate this to our customers?
We recommend simply removing all content related to the Science Kit from your website when the phase out is complete or when you have no more stock to sell, and of course not listing it in your next brochure.
